

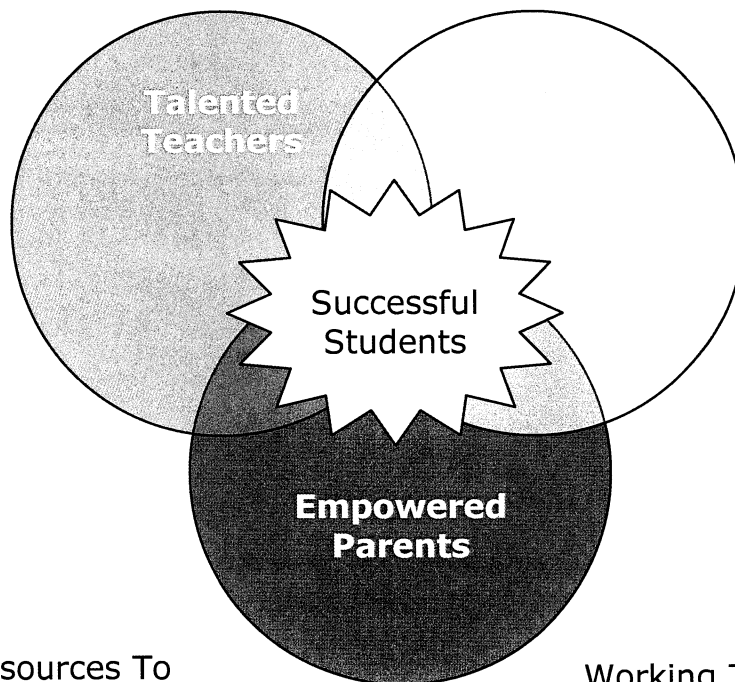

Ellen Mulligan has a Bachelor of Science in Secondary Mathematics from West Chester University. She graduated summa cum laude with an M.A. in Curriculum, Instruction, and Supervision from Rider University, where she won the Graduate award for her major. She was named Distinguished Educator for the Philadelphia Archdiocese in 1988. Ellen has over 40 years' experience in classroom teaching from grade school to college, in school district curriculum development, in supervising K-12 math teachers, and in one-on-one tutoring with children who need individual attention or help with SAT prep.

Ellen provided extensive teacher training for two publishing companies. She was a group leader in the initiative to establish the New Jersey State Standards. For two years she worked with the teachers in the Trenton School District to help them align their curriculum to state standards and to write effective lesson plans. She also traveled to military bases in Germany, Korea, and the United States to train teachers employed by the Department of Defense.



Tracey Knerr has a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education and a Master of Education in Elementary and Middle School Mathematics from Indiana University of Pennsylvania. She has completed all but her dissertation for her Doctorate in Education degree, with a concentration in math education, from Rutgers University. Tracey has 23 years experience as an elementary classroom teacher, an elementary math specialist, an assistant professor, and a teacher trainer.
