How Can Parents Help Improve Children's Writing Skills at Home?

- * **Provide a Quiet Place.**
- * **Have the Materials.**
- * **Allow Time.**

- * **Brainstorm Ideas.**
- * **Praise.**
- * **Respond To Them.**

- * **Make Language Fun.**
- * **Provide Opportunities to Read.**
- * **Communicate with Teacher.**

Writing Tips for Use With Younger Children...

- *Get them used to making the shapes of the letters.**
- *Accept sloppy work.**
- *Encourage "scribble" writing.**

- *Allow them to spell words phonetically.**
- *Encourage copying and drawing.**
- *Explore new experiences with your child.**

- * Help them make labels, cards, and books.**
- *Teach /Practice Conversational Skills.**
- * Real Aloud on a regular basis...do a picture story.**

- * Write a story with your child.**
- * If your child would like to write their own story, help brainstorm ideas...**
 - * they can write about**
 - * what will happen**
 - * how it will end**
